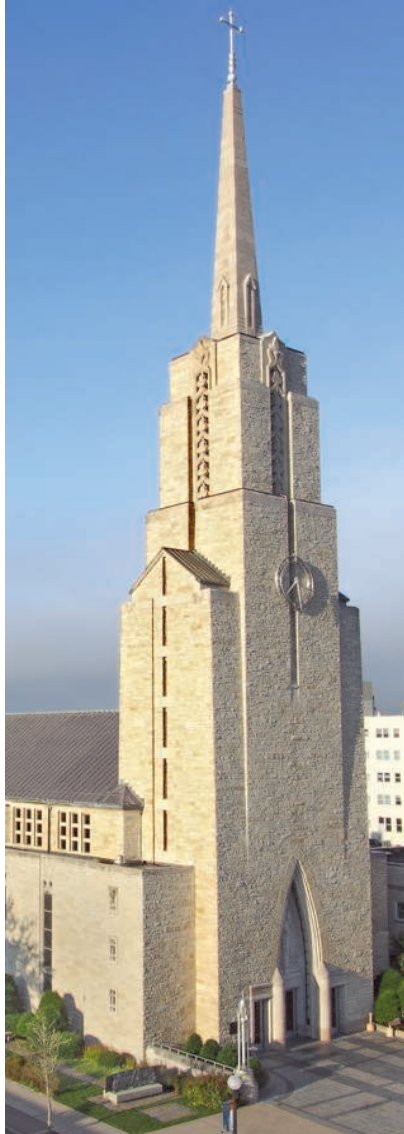

RIDING THE RAILS OF LIFE



Dear parishioners and visitors,

The celebrations of the Most Holy Trinity and Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ are this and next Sundays respectively. These are some of the most important tenets in the Catholic Faith. It has been tradition over 100 years to have the celebration of the Most Holy Trinity the Sunday after Pentecost. It is to reflect upon the mystery of the three persons in one God. If you were to sit down and read the bible, you will read the existence and work of each person. God the Father revealed to Moses in the burning bush that He is a singular being. Jesus preached that the Father and He are one. Also, He said He would return to the Father and He will send the Advocate to be with people until the end of time.

The Holy Body and Blood of Christ is another most important tenet. We believe that Christ gives His very self to us in the Holy Eucharist. The synoptic gospels (*Matthew, Mark and Luke*) recorded that sacred event of the Last Supper, and St. Paul wrote it in one of his letters (*I Corinthians*) the celebration of the Mass. It was tradition in the Church to celebrate this solemnity on Thursday in the second week after Pentecost. It was the United States Council of Catholic Bishops who requested several decades ago to move it to the nearest Sunday so that more of the faithful would appreciate and celebrate it.

I hope you will cherish these great tenets and mysteries of the Faith as well as the other great solemnities this month such as the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, and Sts. Peter and Paul.

This week's featured artisan is Edward Jones, who is a wildlife photographer. Even as a child, Edward delved in some form of photography whether it was with his mother's Kodak Brownie camera or Kodak Instamatic cameras. Presently, he uses professional grade camera bodies and lenses with the highest quality glass available. Given he was raised in a rural setting growing-up, his heart has always been close to wildlife and nature. If you were to ask him what the key elements of doing wildlife photography are, he would say, "patience, perseverance and learning the subject's behaviors."

As Edward knows, there is no shortage of wildlife to photograph year round. Owls and raptors are plentiful in late fall and into the winter months. With the advent of spring, water fowl make their appearances on open waters, later followed by song birds along with warblers, and lastly, the arrival of shorebirds. He also enjoys taking classes at The Camera Company in Madison and going on their outings to try different forms of photography mediums and styles.

Edward travels extensively through the upper mid-west, but his true love is photographing foxes in La Crosse and in particular, fox kits.
