# **RIDING THE RAILS OF LIFE**



Dear parishioners and visitors,

What will be the weather like next year you ask? Well, let not me be the one but The Old Farmer's Almanac tell you. Since I do not have the ability nor faculty to predict the weather, let's turn to the professional for that information. Last year, the almanac was 83% correct in temperature and 72% in precipitation which the norm is 80% for both. So there is no greater source than the almanac itself.

Here is the prediction from November 1, 2018 – October 31, 2019. Please note that La Crosse is located in the very south and center of the region to which it is referring:

Winter will be slightly milder and drier than normal, with snowfall near to below normal. The coldest periods will be early to mid-December, from late December into January, and from late January into February. The snowiest periods will be mid and late November, early and mid-December, and early and late March. April and May will be slightly cooler and rainier than normal. Summer will be slightly cooler than normal, with the hottest periods in late June, late July, and early to mid-August. Rainfall will be above normal in the east and below normal in the west. September and October will be slightly rainier than normal, with near-normal temperatures.

Last frost in spring: May 12, 2019  
First frost in fall: September 28, 2019

## Weekly Message From THE HOLY SEE



## POPE FRANCIS

Jesus, many times in His preaching, cautions us to be vigilant, to hold vigil, and keep watch". He added that on one occasion, Jesus advised watchfulness, "for the Son of man is coming at an hour you do not expect. Indeed, "vigilance" should be practiced "in relation to the coming of the Lord". On other occasions Jesus makes this same recommendation emphasizing the importance of "being prepared", for example, in the case of the ten maidens; both the prudent ones and those who were imprudent or unprepared". The former "had everything prepared, even the oil for the lamps"; the latter, however were complaisant, "without a thought to being prepared". Thus, Jesus warns: "be vigilant". He advises "watchfulness, prayer and vigilance", explained Francis, "in order to avoid temptation". The Pope then referred to the example of Jesus instructing His disciples in the garden of Olives. "They fell asleep out of fear" He said. Jesus told them to "watch and pray that you may not enter into temptation" (Mt 26:41).


