Genuflecting: "I give you my life."

Today I take up genuflection, literally coming from two Latin words "to bend the knee". In the Latin/Western Rite of the Roman Catholic Church we have the custom of genuflecting to Our Lord present in the Blessed Sacrament. It is not necessary to make the sign of the cross when you do so. That is a completely separate act. It isn't wrong to do so, however. It is customary to genuflect on the right knee. In the "old days" it was stipulated that you do a single genuflection before Him dwelling the Tabernacle and a double genuflection (both knees on the floor at the same time) before His "unveiled" Presence when for example He is visibly present in the monstrance at Adoration or on Holy Thursday night. This distinction was done away with for some time now. However, it is not wrong to maintain that piety of a double genuflection. I think it is fitting and beautiful. Let it be noted that twice a year we do a double genuflection during the Creed on the bookends of the Incarnation: Solemnities of the Annunciation and the Nativity of the Lord.

Here at the Cathedral we do not genuflect when we enter into the pew. Instead, we make a profound bow from the hips. Why? Because there is no Tabernacle before you. Only genuflect if you can actually see the Tabernacle (in any church) and lock in on Him. I realize that sometimes we do things out of habit, but that's the problem. The genuflection should be a conscious act of connecting with Him and speaking to Him. It really is (or at least can

be) a tremendous act of Faith. Whisper a prayer when you genuflect so it doesn't become some empty act. He actually does hear you! And likewise, He hears nothing and is saddened when we say nothing! Whisper to Him aloud (when appropriate) or in the quietness of your soul something like "Jesus, I adore you!" "Jesus, I love you!" "Jesus, I believe in your Holy Presence!" or "Jesus, I love you and believe in you for those who do not love you or believe in you." as an act of reparation. The only time (I can think of) we do genuflect not in His Presence is Good Friday when we exit the church and genuflect to the cross in the sanctuary.

Where does this practice of genuflecting come from? Well, like many things we co-opted it from the pagans, "baptizing" it and making it our own—just like the date of Christmas (we don't know what actual date on which He was born). So, the practice was that when you came into the presence of Caesar Augustus who was thought to be a semi-god, you paid him proper respect by going down on one knee and bending the head with the idea that: My life is yours. Dispatch me with the sword to my neck if you wish! If this is the case for a mere mortal, then how much more so ought we to do this for God? Now of course we do so not with the idea of "take my life" but rather "*I give you my life*" – you Lord who are Lord of lords and the giver of life!

The other thing to be mindful of is this: Have you ever considered how many angels are in His Holy Presence in every place in the world in which the Eucharist is? Just think! When you genuflect, you join a cloud of adoring persons – these purely spiritual creatures with whom God willing we will spend all of Eternity. So, let's get a head start! St. Joseph the Workman, Pray for us!

SACRAMENTS & SERVICES

Marriage

Couples requesting the celebration of the Sacrament of Marriage should contact the rector at the time of formal engagement or at least six months prior to the anticipated date of marriage. If a couple wishes to be married as a registered member of our parish, they must actively participate in the faith (Sunday worship) and be a registered member of Cathedral parish at least three months prior to requesting the Sacrament of Marriage. Weddings are not celebrated during Lent.

Baptism

Parents may request the baptism of their infants at least two months prior to the anticipated date of baptism. To request baptism, please call 782-0322.

Wills & Estates

As you prayerfully execute your will or do estate planning, please consider keeping the Cathedral of St. Joseph the Workman in mind. The most common and simplest way to include the parish in your last wishes is to include a bequest in your will or trust.

Hospital Visits & Visitation of the Sick:

To secure a priest for unplanned or emergency admissions to a local hospital, it is important that the patient, if possible, or a family member and/or friends, contact the hospital pastoral care department to have the on-call priest administer the sacraments. The on-call priest is considered part of the pastoral team and does not count toward the maximum number of visitors per day rule.

If you become homebound because of illness or a post hospital stay, and would like to be visited; or those who are seriously ill or have been sick for a long period of time should receive the Sacrament of the Sick and Holy Communion. Those with preplanned hospital procedures should call the parish office to make arrangements for anointing. If possible, one should be anointed apart from a hospital stay since there are visiting restrictions.

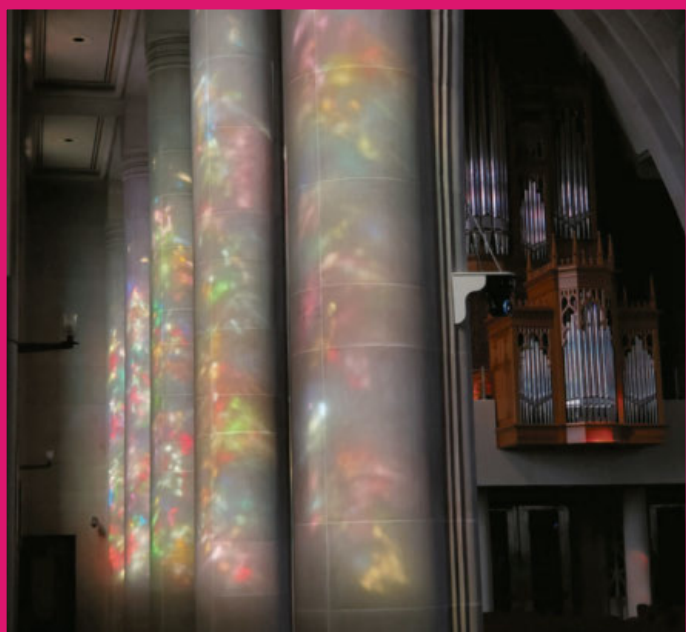

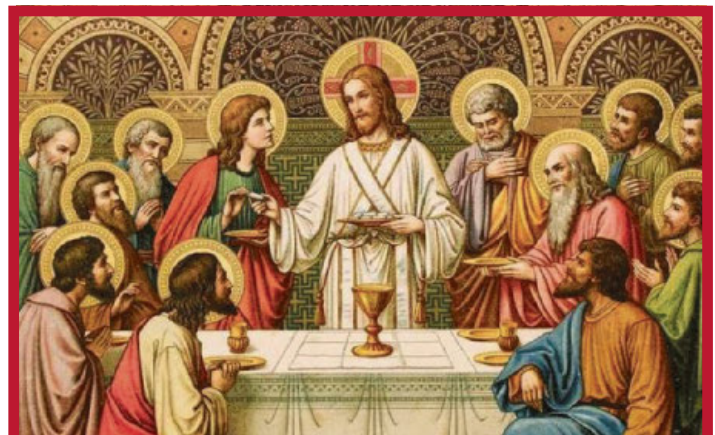


Welcome to the Parish Joe Anderson. Joe, and his fiancé Jessica Hundt, will be getting married here at the Cathedral on August 13th 2022.

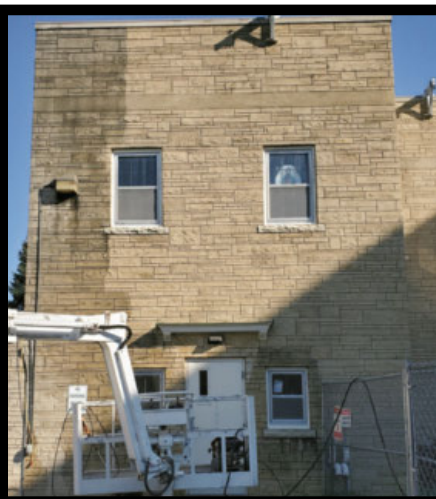
