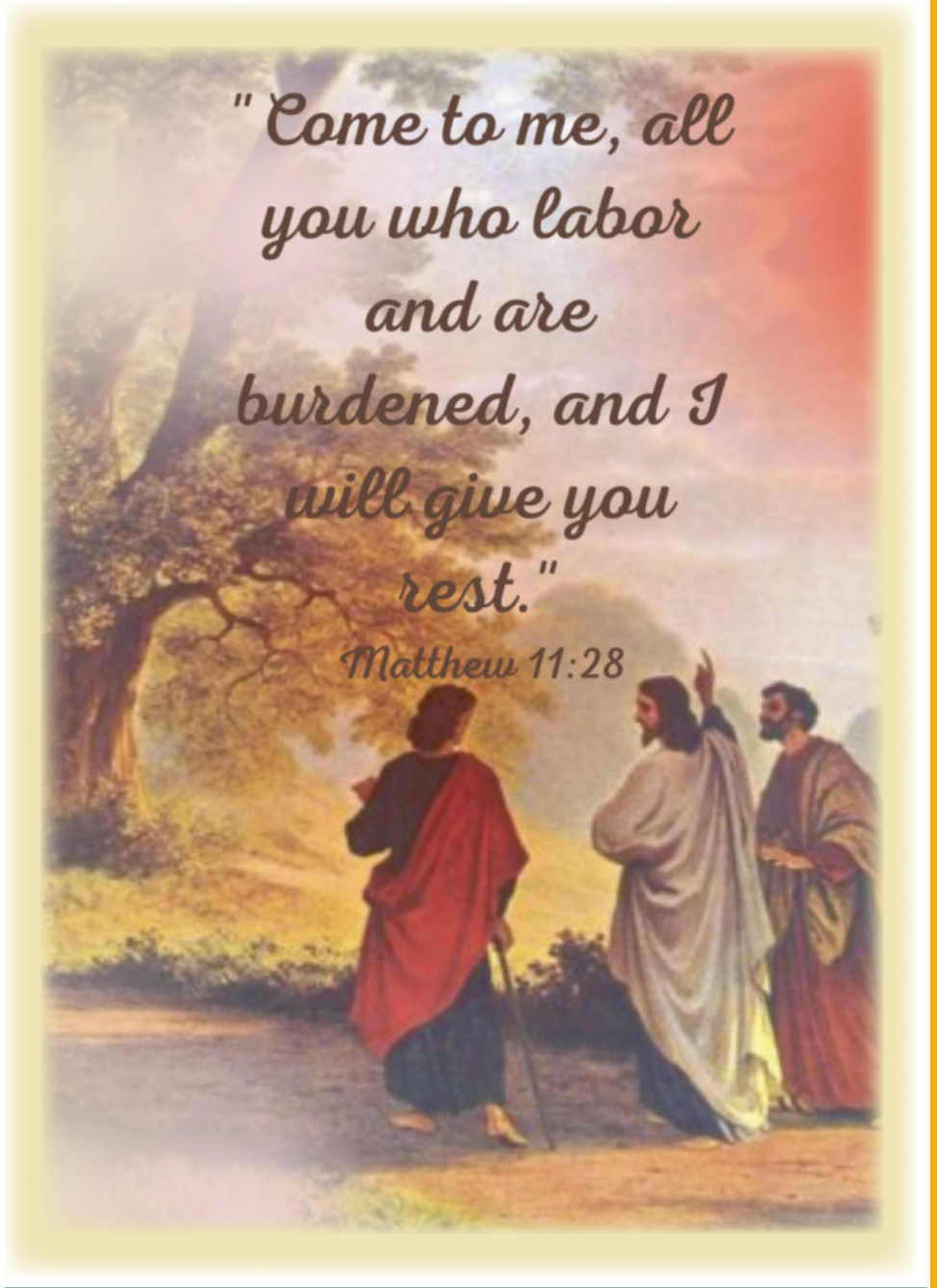
Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is held each Wednesday from 7 am - 7 pm including Benediction at noon and resuming after the 12:10 pm Mass.

### ***Fear of the Lord***

For the next several weeks, I will be focusing my columns on the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit.

In Baptism we receive all seven gifts of the Holy Spirit, and then again in all of their fullness at Confirmation. The job of the Holy Spirit and His Gifts are to close the gap between what ought to be and what is in our relationship with God. The first gift we take a look at is Fear of the Lord. It is the first gift upon which the others build. First of all, it is a gift. So, it's a good thing, right? It might not sound like it, but it is. Fear of the Lord helps us to fear the right thing: sin. That's the only thing we really need to fear because it is the only thing which can

compromise our salvation. So, the rest we can deal with. Fear of the Lord is a sovereign, loving respect for God, so much so that we absolutely dread nothing more than offending the Good God by our sin. It does not arise from the thought of hell, but rather from this agonizing thought that I've hurt the one Person who loves me more than anyone in the world. Also, Fear of the Lord detaches us from worldly pleasures that could in any way separate us from God. It helps us to remember that our deeds go with us. We don't get to "check them at the door" but they follow us into the afterlife, understanding that we will be judged by the works we have done in the body—both good and bad. This should not fill us with "fear," but with confidence that we can do the right thing. With God's grace, all things are possible. Ask for the grace and it will be given. Courage!

## **SACRAMENTS & SERVICES**

### **Marriage**

Couples requesting the celebration of the Sacrament of Marriage should contact the rector at the time of formal engagement or at least six months prior to the anticipated date of marriage. If a couple wishes to be married as a registered member of our parish, they must actively participate in the faith (Sunday worship) and be a registered member of Cathedral parish at least three months prior to requesting the Sacrament of Marriage. Weddings are not celebrated during Lent.

### **Baptism**

Parents may request the baptism of their infants at least two months prior to the anticipated date of baptism. To request baptism, please call 782-0322.

### **Wills & Estates**

As you prayerfully execute your will or do estate planning, please consider keeping the Cathedral of St. Joseph the Workman in mind. The most common and simplest way to include the parish in your last wishes is to include a bequest in your will or trust.

### **Hospital Visits & Visitation of the Sick:**

To secure a priest for unplanned or emergency admissions to a local hospital, it is important that the patient, if possible, or a family member and/or friends, contact the hospital pastoral care department to have the on-call priest administer the sacraments.

If you become homebound because of illness or a post hospital stay, and would like to be visited; or those who are seriously ill or have been sick for a long period of time should receive the Sacrament of the Sick and Holy Communion. Those with preplanned hospital procedures should call the parish office to make arrangements for anointing. If possible, one should be anointed apart from a hospital stay.

## SPIRITUAL REFLECTIONS FOR - JULY 9

Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

The theme of humility is central to our readings today. God Himself is a humble God, so if we wish to follow Him as Christian stewards, we must be humble. Humility is crucial to the stewardship way of life and to a peaceful and fulfilling life. In our Gospel passage from Matthew, Jesus Himself speaks to the Father about the privileged role that humble souls play in God's plan of salvation. "I give praise to you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, for although you have hidden these things from the wise and the learned you have revealed them to little ones." What does it mean to be a "little one"? It means that we acknowledge we don't have it all figured out but are very much in need of a savior. It means we recognize that all we are and have is a gift from God. It means we embrace the stewardship way of life. It is not easy, but deep peace and consolation come with this way of life. Jesus offers these warm and encouraging words to entice us to embrace them. "Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am meek and humble of heart; and you will find rest for yourselves. For my yoke is easy, and my burden light." Let us resolve to follow in the footsteps of our Savior, embracing the humble path of stewardship. The way leads to peace here and now and ultimately leads us to heaven.
