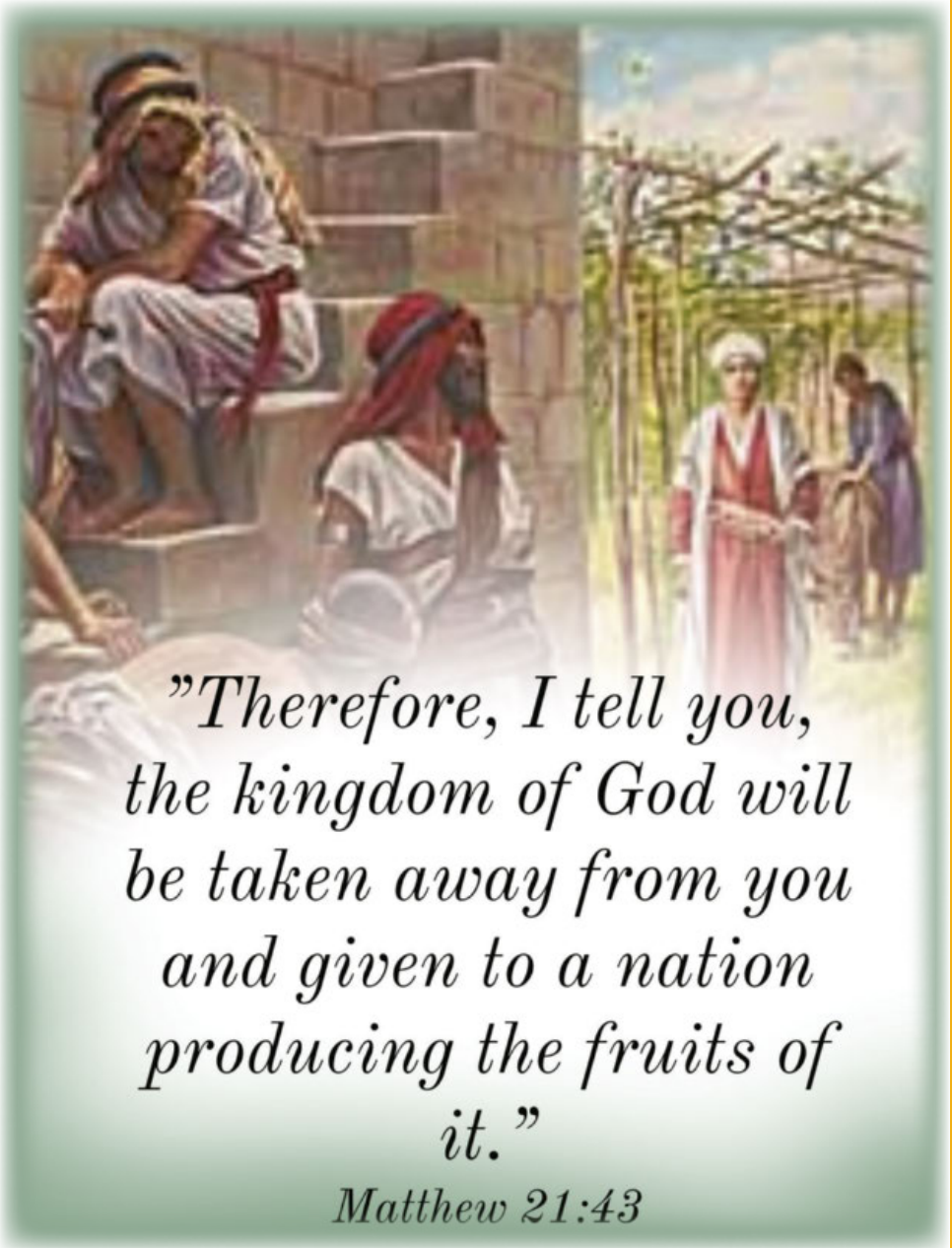
Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is held each Wednesday from 7 am - 7 pm including Benediction at noon and resuming after the 12:10 pm Mass.

God's Great Proposal; Her Work Is Ours

We are "on the hook" for one another—that is to say for the salvation of the souls of others. Call it accountability. I think of those spiritual works of mercy which touch so directly upon this role we undertake in the Body of Christ: admonishing the sinner; instructing the ignorant; counseling the doubtful; comforting the sorrowful; bearing wrongs patiently; forgiving all injuries; and praying for the living and the dead. Our friend St. John Vianney stated it this way: "My little children, reflect on these words: the Christian's treasure is not on earth but in heaven. Our thoughts, then, ought to be directed to where our treasure is. This is the glorious duty of man: to pray and to love. If you pray and love, that is where a man's happiness lies."

I would like to think that the essence of what we do is motivated by that one holy, noble task: to desire the salvation of souls beginning with our own. Everything we do here as a community can ultimately serve that one purpose. There

is nothing too mundane that cannot be at the service of God in building up His flock in this portion of His vineyard. Everything we do must be motivated by our desire to be in a real, living friendship with Jesus and to help others desire and live that. There is no person in the whole world who has modeled that so well for us other than Mary, our Virgin Queen and Mother. If we follow her lead, we will never fail. Deepen your devotion to Mary and in so doing you will deepen your relationship with Jesus. She was the singular vessel by which God brought salvation, named Jesus, into the world. However, far from being "done"—far from being a one-time only thing—Mary continues to be the chosen conduit by which all graces enter into the world. Her work in service to the Body of Christ continues today. She is the Mediatrix of all Graces. She cooperated with God in a most unique, singular and powerful (but human!) way. She intercedes for us most powerfully with our Lord Jesus before the throne of God the Father. As a disciple of Christ, her work is ours. Her sole intention in saying "yes" to God's great proposal was personally for the salvation of our soul. We owe her a deep debt of gratitude.

SACRAMENTS & SERVICES

Marriage

Couples requesting the celebration of the Sacrament of Marriage should contact the parish office at the time of formal engagement or at least six months prior to the anticipated date of marriage. If a couple wishes to be married as a registered member of our parish, they must actively participate in the faith (Sunday worship) and be a registered member of Cathedral parish for at least three months prior to requesting the Sacrament of Marriage. Weddings are not celebrated during Lent.

RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults)

The RCIA is a process of initiation into the Catholic Church for those who are experiencing a conversion in their lives and desire to be baptized; those who from other Christian traditions seek full communion in the Catholic Church through Eucharist and Confirmation; or for those Catholics who have not received religious education, Confirmation or First Eucharist. This process enables one to come more fully into a relationship with Jesus Christ. To do this we study the Gospels; learn Catholic doctrine and moral teaching; develop and deepen a life of prayer; and live the faith in action. It is not merely a course of instruction but a process of conversion designed to meet the unique and individual needs of the participants. Baptism

Parents may request the baptism of their infants at least two months prior to the anticipated date of baptism. To request baptism, please call 782-0322.

Hospital Visits & Visitation of the Sick

To secure a priest for unplanned or emergency admissions to a local hospital, it is important that the patient, if possible, or a family member and/or friends, contact the hospital pastoral care department to have the on-call priest administer the sacraments.

If you become homebound due to illness, and would like to be visited; or those who are seriously ill, should receive the Sacrament of the Sick and Holy Communion. Those with preplanned hospital procedures should call the parish office to make arrangements for anointing.
