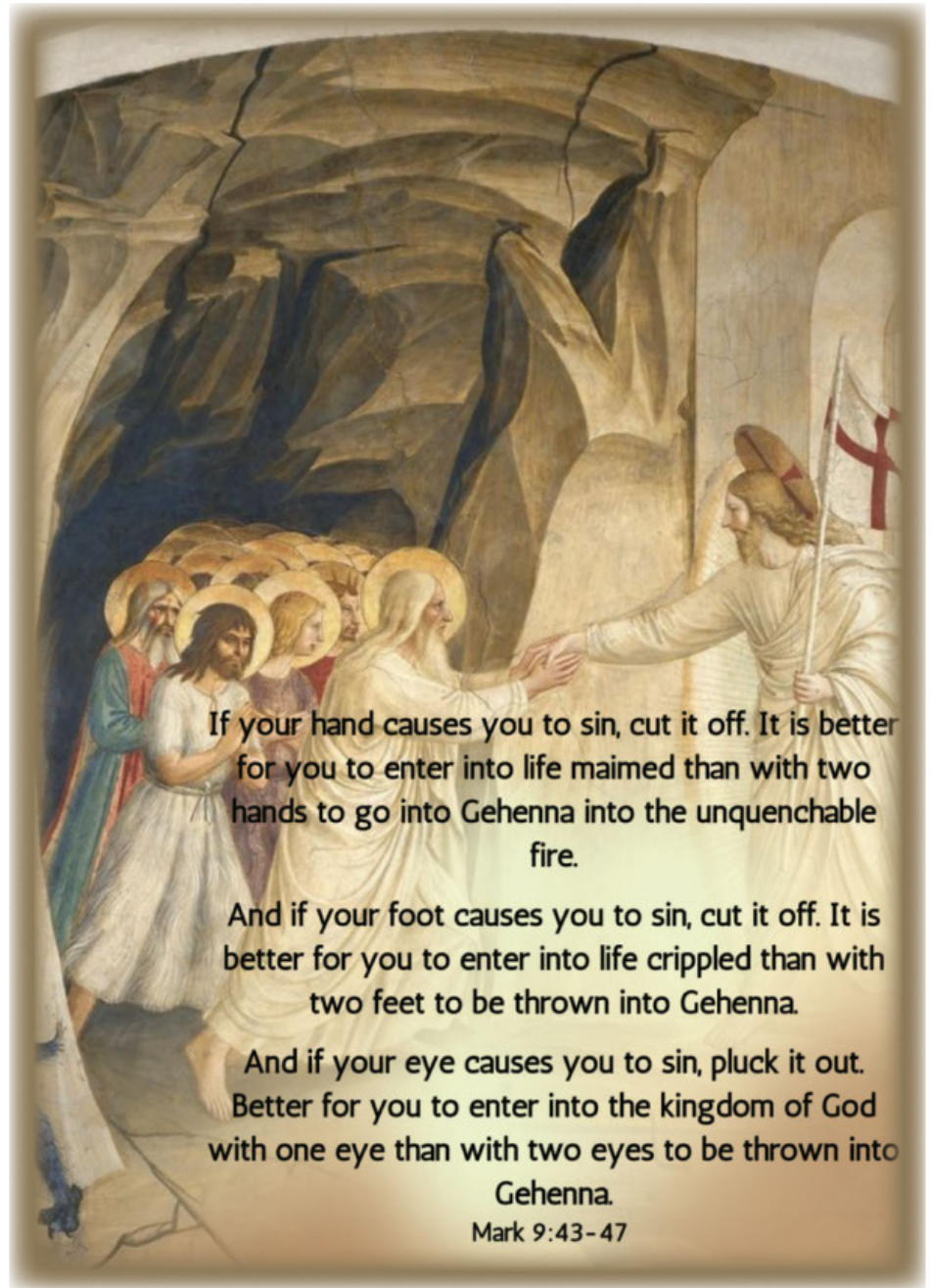
Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is held each Wednesday from 7 am - 7 pm including Benediction at noon and resuming after the 12:10 pm Mass.

Stewardship Reflections - September 29, 2024
Twenty-sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time

In our readings this week, Eldad, Medad, and the man driving out demons were all doing God's work. They had been entrusted with a gift and used it to glorify the Lord. For instance, Eldad and Medad used their gift of prophecy to spread God's word, and the man driving out demons used his gift of healing to alleviate suffering. Joshua and John should have responded with joy and appreciation for each other's gifts and talents. We often see others' strengths as our weaknesses in parish life, the workforce, or even our families. Jesus calls us to remove sinful thoughts and attitudes from our lives. The next time we witness someone being a good steward of God's

gifts — rejoice! And continue to examine how you use your gifts and talents. Take time for self-reflection and ask yourself, 'Am I using my gifts and talents to the best of my ability? Am I being a good steward of what God has entrusted me?' We do not want to end up like the rich in our Second Reading from St. James. They stored up their riches to the point where they withheld wages from their workers! They clenched tightly to the pleasures and luxuries the world offers and put them in front of God and their neighbor. They misused the gifts God bestowed on them. We must keep this in perspective as we journey as Christian stewards. We do not live for this life but for the next. He has given us time daily, countless talents, and numerous treasures. Are we using them for His glory? This week, when we witness other people in our lives using God's gifts, instead of becoming jealous or critical, let's take a moment to reflect on what God has gifted us and how we can offer it to Him for His glory. This introspection can help us understand our purpose and contribute to the community.

SACRAMENTS & SERVICES

Marriage

Couples requesting the celebration of the Sacrament of Marriage should contact the parish office at the time of formal engagement or at least six months prior to the anticipated date of marriage. If a couple wishes to be married as a registered member of our parish, they must actively participate in the faith (Sunday worship) and be a registered member of Cathedral parish for at least three months prior to requesting the Sacrament of Marriage. Weddings are not celebrated during Lent.

OCIA (Order of Christian Initiation of Adults)

The OCIA is a process of initiation into the Catholic Church for those who are experiencing a conversion in their lives and desire to be baptized; those who from other Christian traditions seek full communion in the Catholic Church through Eucharist and Confirmation; or for those Catholics who have not received religious education, Confirmation or First Eucharist. This process enables one to come more fully into a relationship with Jesus Christ. To do this we study the Gospels; learn Catholic doctrine and moral teaching; develop and deepen a life of prayer; and live the faith in action. It is not merely a course of instruction but a process of conversion designed to meet the unique and individual needs of the participants. Baptism

Parents may request the baptism of their infants at least two months prior to the anticipated date of baptism. To request baptism, please call 782-0322.

Hospital Visits & Visitation of the Sick

To secure a priest for unplanned or emergency admissions to a local hospital, it is important that the patient, if possible, or a family member and/or friends, contact the Rector to administer the Sacraments. Please call the Parish Office.

If you become homebound due to illness, and would like to be visited; or those who are seriously ill, should receive the Anointing of the Sick and Holy Communion. Those with preplanned hospital procedures should call the parish office to make arrangements for anointing.

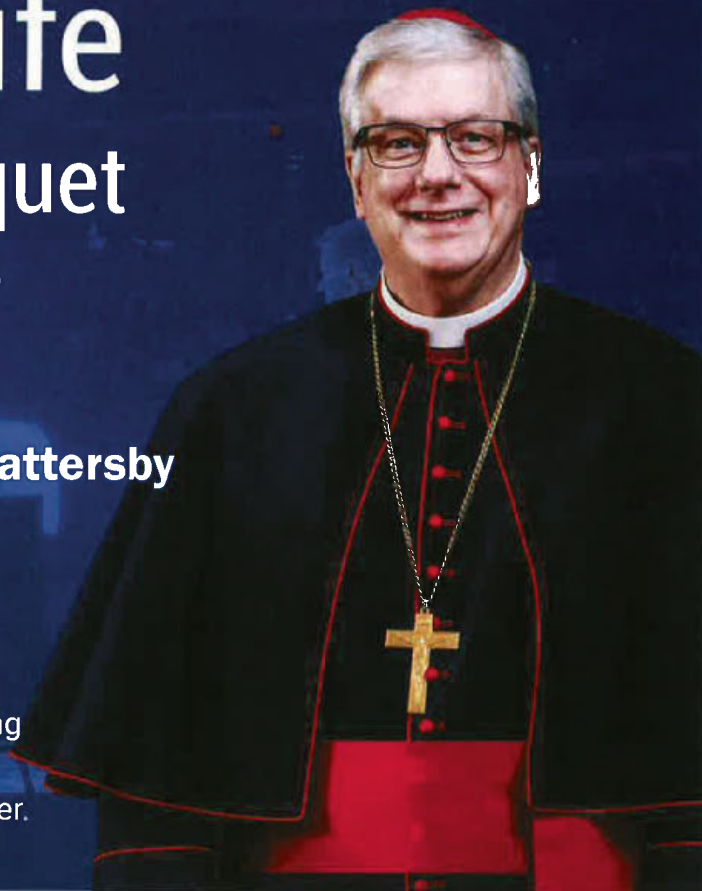


