What it means to be a Parishioner

"For as in one body we have many parts, and all the parts do not have the same function, so we, though



many, are one body in Christ and individually parts of one another."
(Romans 12:4-5)

What is a Parish?

"A parish is a certain

community of the Christian faithful stably constituted in a particular Church, whose pastoral care is entrusted to a parish priest (*parochus*) as its proper pastor under the authority of the diocesan bishop" (*Code of Canon Law*, Can. 515 §1).

What is a Parishioner?

A parishioner can be defined as a Catholic who is registered and *actively* participates in the liturgical and pastoral life of the parish through the sacrificial and proportionate sharing of his or her God-given gifts of *time*, *talent*, and *treasure*.

Why should you register as a parishioner?

The pastor and his staff should know who is under his pastoral care. As a parishioner you have a right to: daily prayers by the pastor; the Sacraments; general spiritual care, and; pastoral education and formation. Our desire is to welcome and cherish you as a member of this family in Christ as you "work out your salvation."

Just as there are *rights* for registered members of the parish, there are also *responsibilities*.

- An active parishioner follows our Lord Jesus Christ as His disciple and strives to be faithful to the Ten Commandments and to the magisterial teachings of the Catholic Church. We are called to lead others to faith by our good example, through loving service to others, and offering our prayers, works, joys, and sufferings for the conversion of the world and the glory of God.
- An active parishioner is a person who has received or is preparing to receive the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation.
- An active parishioner is a person who regularly attends Sunday Mass (weekly) and Holy Days of Obligation at the Cathedral.

- An active parishioner gives of him or herself by donating time, talent, and treasure to the works of the parish and/or to the volunteer organizations and ministries within the Parish. We are to share in the responsibilities that keep our parish alive and thriving, and not just surviving.
- An active parishioner is a good financial steward of the Church. Parishes, like any household, have bills to pay. As a parishioner, it is important to contribute financially to the best of one's ability to the mission and upkeep of the Cathedral church and its campus. I am grateful for and humbled by people's generosity to this parish. I encourage parishioners always to pray and ask the Lord's guidance on what you should tithe to the parish.

Practically speaking, then, an Active Member:

- 1. Is properly registered on the Parish roster with all contact information kept current.
- 2. Faithfully attends weekly Sunday Mass and all Holy Days of Obligation.
- 3. Participates in parish activities and ministries whenever possible.
- 4. Prays for their pastor and the work of the Parish.
- 5. Observes the precepts of the Church:
 - You shall attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation.
 - You shall confess your sins at least once a year.
 - You shall humbly receive the Lord Jesus in Holy Communion at least during the Easter season.
 - You shall observe the prescribed days of fasting and abstinence.
 - The faithful have the obligation of supporting the church.

Of course, we understand that those parishioners who are homebound due to illness or old age may not be able to attend Mass or to support financially the parish. However, we ask those members to pray and to offer some of their sufferings for the work of the parish, its pastor and members.
